### Training

At St. Bartholomew's and Homerton Hospitals, I contributed on a regular weekly basis for ten years to the undergraduate training programme in Neurology until 1995. I have contributed to the development of neurological rehabilitation through publication, lecturing and teaching, and undertaken invited lectures nationally and internationally relating to aspects of brain injury rehabilitation. Until recently I have worked for committees at both national and European levels; this latter commitment was recently reduced in order to maintain the momentum required for an increase in local clinical and research effort. This work has been supported by the initiation and planning, and subsequent publication in 1993, of a comprehensive textbook, "Neurological Rehabilitation". Interest has prompted publication of a paperback version in January 1997, and a second edition is in preparation.
